

Maximum: lose your business licenses



Deadline July 1st

- 1. <u>Distributors must arrange for the laboratory testing and quality assurance for cannabis and cannabis products.</u>
- 2. After testing is completed, the laboratory will generate a certificate of analysis that contains the results of the testing and whether the tested batch passed or failed.
- Testing laboratories are required to develop and implement a quality assurance program that is sufficient to ensure the reliability and validity of the analytical data produced by the laboratory.
